(i) The Examination will be more or less equivalent to that of the first language (Bengali) of the Madhyamik Examination of the Board of Secondary Education, West Bengal and will be held in two parts, viz. Part-I Written, Part-II-Oral, according to syllabus detailed below. No. book is prescribed for the examination.

(ii) Standard of qualificaton: In order to qualify at the examination, a candidate will be required to pass in both the parts in the same examination. Sixty per cent of the total marks in each of Part-1 and Part-1 of the examination will be the pass marks.

3. The Examination will be held by the Public Service Commission, West Bengal, in May and November every year along the Half-yearly Departmental Examination of Probationery Officers in Calcutta.

4. The officers desirous of attending the examination should apply for permission to the Chief Secretary through proper channel in prescribed application form (enclosed). The application should reach Government at least two months before the date of the examination which will be announced by the Public Service

Commission, West Bengal, in the Calcutta Gazette. The Government will thereafter forward the list of

cligible candidates to the aforesaid Commission at least one month before the date of the examination.
